## **RCM Report**

February 12, 2022

Greetings Family,

Your RCM team attended the Show-Me Regional Service Committee January 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. One in person and one virtually. 9 of the 13 areas were represented.

The Regional Chair has reached out to 6 areas that have been absent from the RSC for the last 2 years. After talking with the areas, 4 have been temporarily removed from the roster until they are able to fulfill the responsibilities and requirements of an area, of which one is to have an RCM present at the RSC per our guidelines. The areas removed were Dhoma, Northland, South Central and United KC. These areas are working on solutions to be able to return to the region.

The Regional Chair has asked any group needing insurance for its location to contact their RCM and we will contact the Regional Chair about setting up an insurance policy. The positions of Outreach Chair, Alt Treasurer, and PR Chair all passed. We still have open positions for Literature Chair, Campvention Chair, Alt Secretary, and Writing Steps for Recovery Chair. The ad hoc committee tasked with writing guidelines for Outreach Chair has turned in guidelines to the Outreach Committee for approval. Once the committee approves them we will bring them to the groups to be voted on.

To adopt the YAP-BLMT Phone Line service for the Show Me Region as a single number helpline.

- 1. Purchase a number from the Twilio service for approximately \$1.00
- 2. Purchase \$50.00 worth of credit from Twilio for 8 cents per call, 0.7 cents per text message to get started.
- 3. Webmaster will install program for YAP-BMLT on Region Server
- 4. PR committee to manage/appoint a manager to oversee the volunteers/operations:
